Revision of reserved seating policy effective as of 14 September 2016

The Management Committee acknowledges that because of temporary or permanent infirmity, some players may require reserved seating arrangements for bridge sessions. Such reserved seating will only be available for normal sessions of the Club and cannot be extended to Club Championships and Congress events. Players and TDs may not reserve seats for friends and arriving early may not guarantee a stationary seat for the session.

The TD is authorized to re-arrange seating to achieve a practical and equitable movement. If this is necessary, players may be asked to sit East-West or to move to another table. The TD will endeavour to be fair by sharing such requests amongst different players over time.
