

RESERVED STATIONARY SEATING

The Management Committee acknowledges that because of temporary or permanent disability, some players may require reserved stationary seating for bridge sessions.

- (i) Such reserved stationary seating will be provided at most sessions, but cannot be guaranteed to all players in need at small sessions and Club Championships.
- (ii) The regular TD for each session will maintain a list of players for whom stationary seats are reserved, and their preferred location; such list to be kept in the TD File in the TD bookshelf.
- (iii) Players for whom reserved seats are provided should advise the TD of the day if they will not be attending. Players who do not attend regularly on specific days should advise the TD at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
- (iv) The TD is authorised to rearrange seating to achieve a practical and equitable movement. If this is necessary, players may be asked to sit E/W or move to another table. The TD will endeavour to be fair by sharing such requests amongst different players over time.
